What is Schools Plus?

- We support students and families
- We help students experience success at school
- We are a model of delivering services (not a program)
- We are collaborative and wrap-around – we work with other partners and/ or support services within and outside of schools
- We can offer informal psycho-education to parents, students, and staff
- We can offer group programming, for example: Options to Anger, Kids Have Stress, Friends for Life, Voices, Parenting groups

Who is served by Schools Plus?

- All children, youth and their families
- In particular, those who:
 - need to increase their engagement in school;
 - have exhausted the usual interventions;
 - need to be connected with services for support;
 - are involved with various agencies need to bridge the gap

Who is Schools Plus?

- Assistant Lead
- Community Outreach Worker
- Mental Health Clinician - Junior High and High School ONLY
- Child & Youth Care Practitioners

How do Referrals occur?

- School Program Planning Teams / School Admin
- Other Service Providers (Health, Justice, DCS)
- Self-referral
